Presenter decisions will be announced in June 2016.

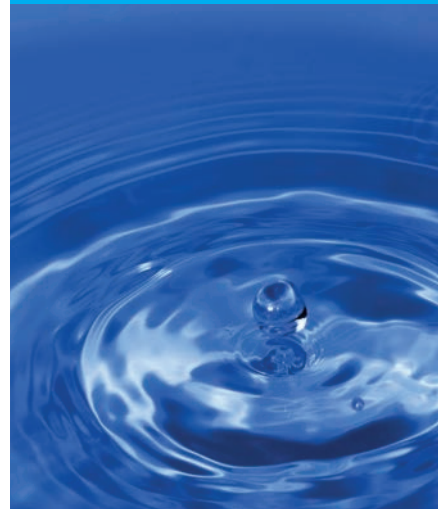
